- MA-OW 2.1 Competitors shall confirm their participation to the Organising committee not later than one o'clock p.m. (13:00) on the day prior to the event.
- MA-OW 2.2 Competitors will be seeded in waves according to age groups. Competitors may be selected irrespective of gender.
- MA-OW 2.3 All competitors will receive and must wear a brightly coloured numbered cap according to the seeding. When water temperature is under 18°C wetsuit can be worn. All swimsuits (also wetsuit) must be according to World Aquatics rules.
- MA-OW 2.4 For the European Aquatics Masters Championship a cut off time of 30 minutes per kilometre may be applied.
